Dear Sirs,

4. Nothing in this letter operates to relieve MSC of any of its obligations or liabilities under the contract of carriage.
5. The validity of this letter of authority will cease twelve (12) months from the date of this letter, after which time the authorisation shall be deemed to have expired. Within that 12 month period, we reserve the right to cancel this authorisation at any time by notification to MSC in writing.
